- Fees due: April 29, 2026
- Entry fee: \$10.00 per CDE team

### Parking Information

#### Weekend Parking (Saturday-Sunday):

Parking in the garage and flat lots is free, and no registration is required.

- *Restricted lots, reserved stalls, dorm lots, and Jardine lots are still monitored 24/7.*

#### Weekday Parking (Monday/Tuesday of CDEs):

All vehicles must be registered each day to avoid a citation. *Parking is \$6.00 per license plate, per day. Each registration using the promo code below will get you parking for the whole day in both garage and surface lots.*

- Register your vehicle the day you park (passes cannot be reserved in-advance):

- Select the first-rate option
- Enter promo code: **PGT540**
- Complete this process separately for each day you park



**Important:**

- Parking is allowed in both flat lots and the parking garage
- All parking is nose-in only
- Your license plate must be entered accurately during registration to avoid a citation

**Bus Parking & Drop-Off**

- Buses may park in C1 and C2 lots near the K-State Rec Center
- Buses cannot stop south of the parking garage entrance on MLK Jr. Drive
- Buses may stop north of the entrance in the designated bus lane or in the circle for unloading
- Additional unloading is available in D1 lot (west of Memorial Field). This is a temporary solution and buses should only be stopped here for 10 minutes. Bus drivers should be prepared to move if parked vehicles need to exit their space.
  - Crosswalks are available on Denison (northeast corner) and near the Union
