## Written Exam Information

The Ag Mechanics Written Exam consists of 49 multiple choice and True/False questions. Questions on this exam cover basic carpentry, electrical, welding, and technical applications of math. This exam is given in an online format, and is delivered using a Learning Management System. There is one correct response per question. DO NOT print the exam in whole or in part.

Students will each have 30 minutes on this exam. A calculator, blank scratch paper, and pen/pencil are allowed. No other notes, books, or resources are allowed to be used. Students should be monitored at all times by an independent proctor. FFA advisors or instructors are not allowed to proctor.

Proctor guidelines:

- Verify identity of each individual test taker.
- Insure that questions and/or answer options are not copied.
- Blank scratch paper should be provided.
- Scratch paper does not leave the testing area.
- Scratch paper MUST be destroyed upon completion of the exam.

Violation of any of these guidelines will result in invalid exam scores.
