General Information

The 2021 Dairy Cattle CDE will be hosted virtually. Contestants should plan for 6 placing classes. These will be a mix of heifer and cow classes. The contest could change based on the availability and quality of video footages. The contest will omit oral reasons for this year and contestants will have 3 sets of questions, each set containing 10 questions to answer from notes taken during the placing classes.

A 50 question general dairy exam will be given at the beginning of the event covering heifer and calf management. Students will have 20 minutes to complete the exam. References available at the Kansas FFA website under the Dairy CDE folder.

Students should have pencils, a clipboard and blank paper. No other notes or notebooks will be allowed in the contest.

Students are expected to do their own work without input from others.

No cell phones or electronic devices are allowed during the contest. Please do not allow students to have them on them!
